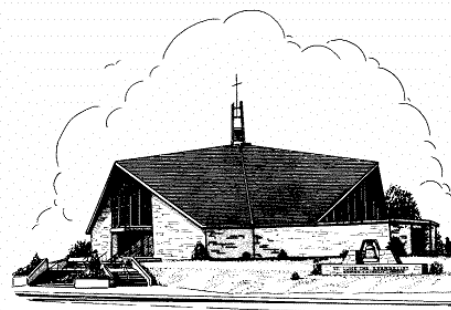

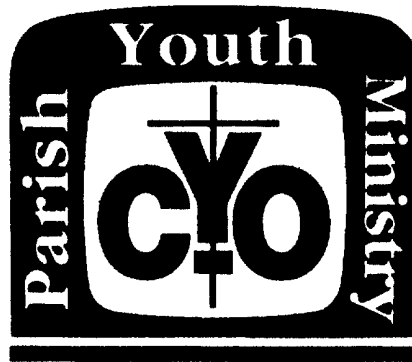

**SISTER WILLIAM ADELE DISTINGUISHED PRINCIPAL AWARD RECIPIENT!**

In September, we reported that our own Principal, Sister William Adele, SSJ, had been nominated as a candidate to be considered for the **2009 Dr. Robert J. Kealey Distinguished Principal Award** by the NCEA (*National Catholic Educational Association*). On Wednesday night, December 17, Mary Rochford (*Superintendent of Schools, Archdiocese of Philadelphia*) and Sr. Edward William Quinn, IHM (*Director of Elementary Curriculum and Instruction, Archdiocese of Philadelphia*) paid a surprise visit to St. Luke's to announce that Sr. William has been named **Distinguished Principal for 2009**. The presentation took place before the school Christmas event in church.

Each fall, the superintendent of schools in *each* diocese/archdiocese in the country is invited to nominate *one* principal for this award. From these nominees, twelve principals, one from each of 12 regions, are selected each year to receive the award at the annual NCEA Convention. Sister William has been selected as the award recipient for Region 3 (which encompasses **all** elementary schools in all of Pennsylvania and New Jersey – over a dozen diocese in all,) and will travel to Anaheim, CA in April for the award presentation at the NCEA Convention. This award is especially meaningful for Sister this year, as this is her 25th year as an Elementary School Principal.

***A Tragic Commemoration***

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court, in the Roe vs. Wade decision, made its worst mistake in history. By declaring that children in the womb are not “persons,” it opened the door to tens of millions of abortions. The website of the Alan Guttmacher Institute (the research arm of Planned Parenthood, which is the single largest perpetrator of abortions in America), states, “From 1973 through 2002, more than 42 million legal abortions occurred.” It also points out that “24% of all pregnancies (excluding miscarriages) end in abortion,” and that abortions after 21 weeks of pregnancy number somewhere around 18,000 per year in America. In 2002, there were 1.29 million abortions in our country. Indeed, as we mark another Roe vs. Wade commemoration, it is time for all of us to get involved in the efforts to end abortion.
